Terms of Reference (TOR)

About KCD

KCD is a non-profit, non-governmental, non-religious, independent local organization that registered in 2005 with the Ministry of Interior of the Royal Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia. KCD's vision is a peaceful developing multicultural society, in which the genuine needs and rights of all stakeholders, regardless their gender, age, ethnicity, religious belief, ability or social status, are recognized, respected, and satisfied, in the respect of environment.

Since 2006, KCD has been implementing activities focusing on children's rights programs, peace projects and nutrition. In Cambodia, KCD is one of the few grassroots organizations that integrate ethnic Vietnamese as a target group. With a lot of courage and perseverance, they stand up for their interests and lead young generations to an increased exchange and to the pointing out of the danger of stereotypes and exclusion.

Through support from Bread for the World (BfdW), Quaker Service Australia (QSA), and Community for Children (C4C); KCD is now looking for the consultant shall guide the KCD Executive Director and staff in the process of developing a monitoring evaluation, reporting and learning system for the Bread for the World (BfdW) funded project, by providing guidance to the Peace Building Community Development and Child Rights teams.

The BfdW-funded project "Inter-Ethnic Peace and Development (IEPD), Child Rights, Peace and Development in Eastern provinces of Cambodia close to Vietnam" will be implemented from 01st October 2017 -30th September 2020.

Purpose and scope of consultancy

In the third year of the project, the consultant will continue to help staff to understand how to:

1. Monitor the achievement of the project objectives using the indicators described in the proposal.
2. Monitor changes in context and unexpected project impacts.
3. Learn from experience and update the project plan in response to changes in context.

Time Schedule The completion of this work is expected to take a maximum of ten (10) days following the signing of the contract, spread over a period of approximately 4 months, during June to September 2020.
